

Deny Assistance for Mass Deportations

Trump and his team are moving full speed ahead to enact his Day 1 campaign promise to conduct a mass deportation of 10+ million undocumented immigrants from the United States. He is expected to name immigration hardliner Stephen Miller as his deputy chief of staff and Project 2025 co-author Thomas Homan as his "border czar."
